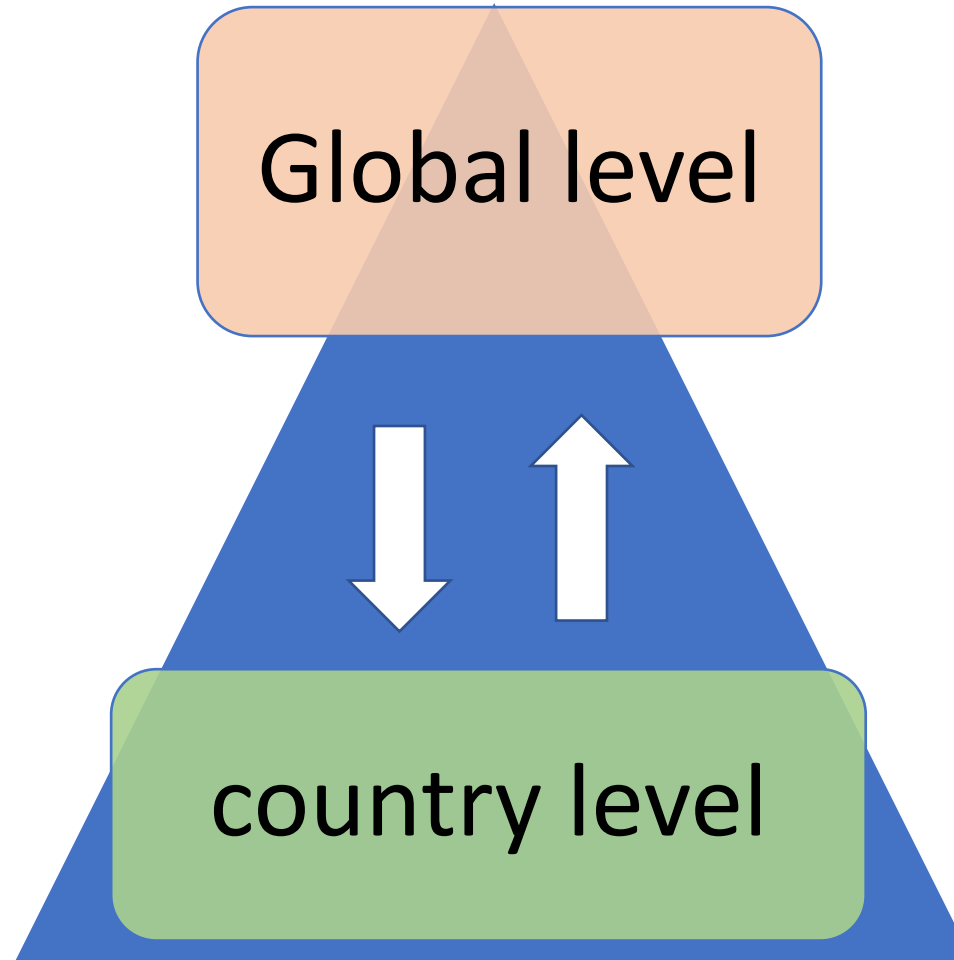

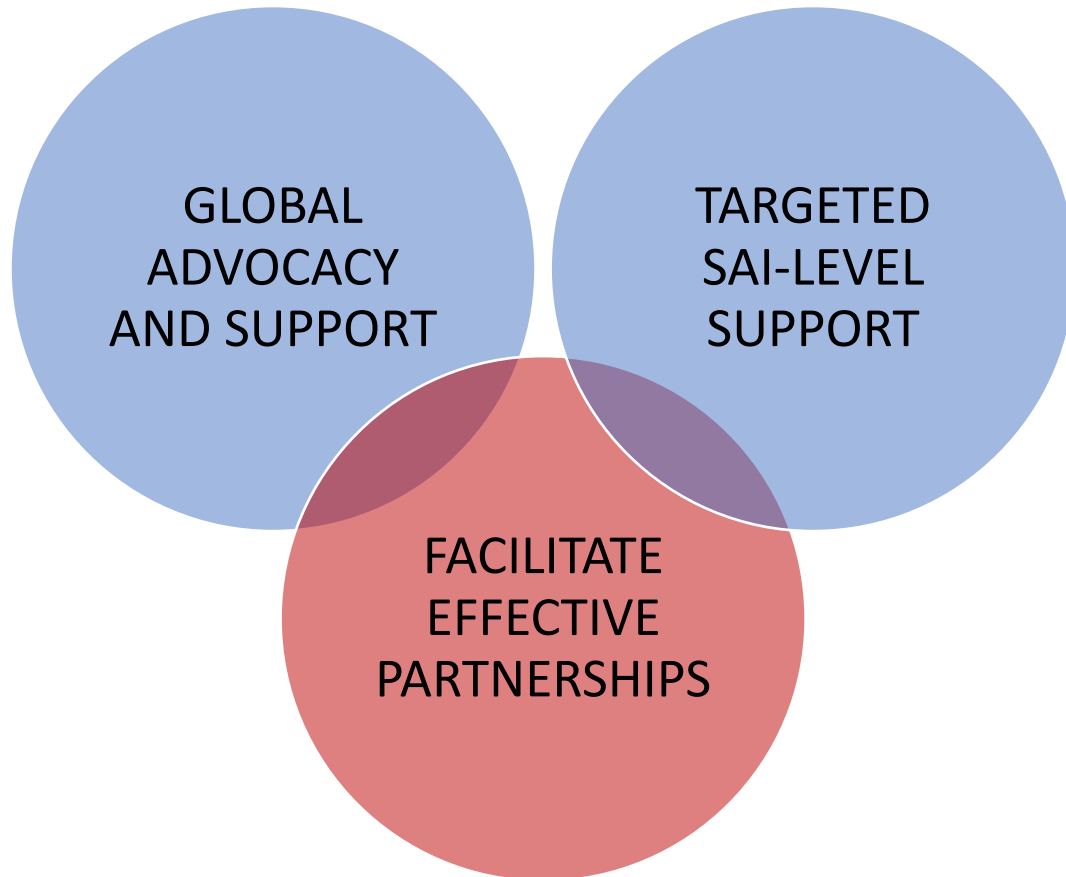

SAI Independence: SIRAM

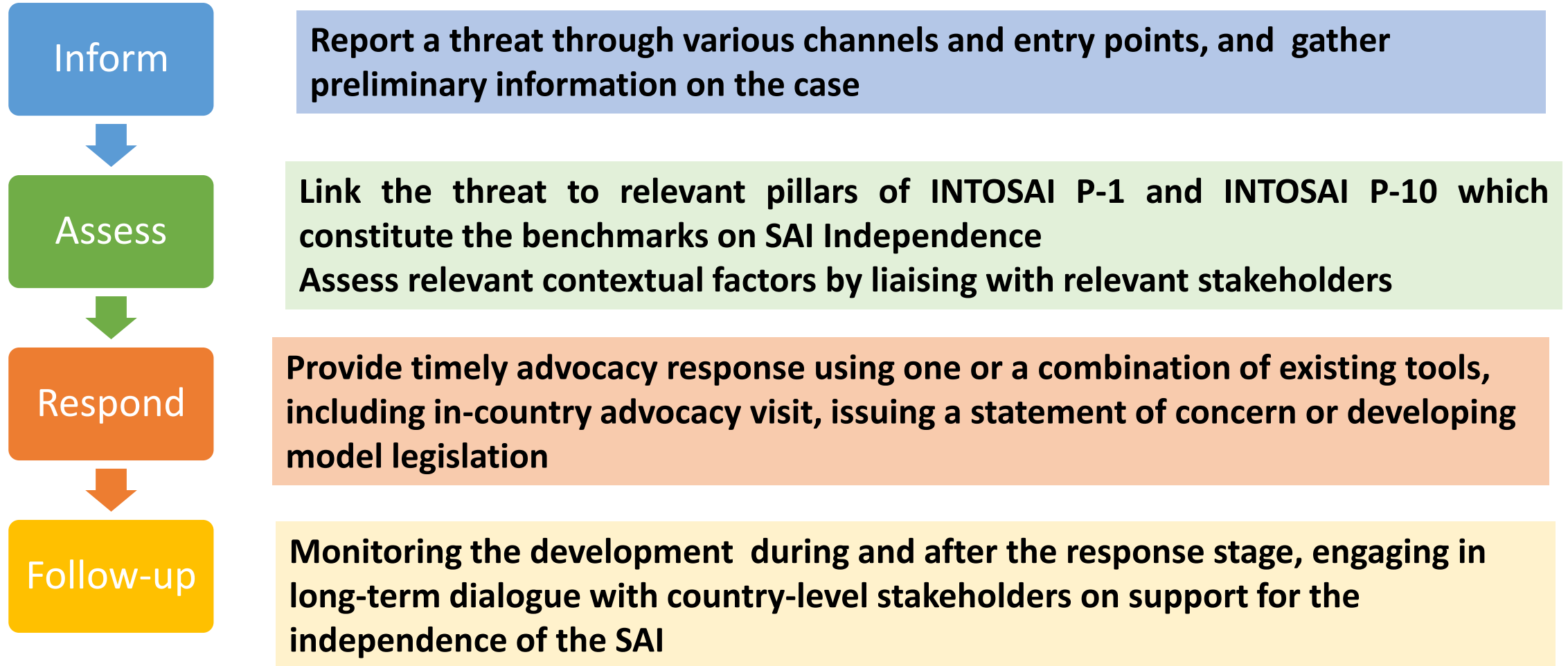
Continuous monitoring and agile advocacy are key to maintain SAI independence

SIRAM's (SAI Independence Rapid Advocacy Mechanism) rollout over the last years has yielded some promising results and could form the basis for a more systematic approach to advocacy for SAI independence

SIRAM's 4-Stages

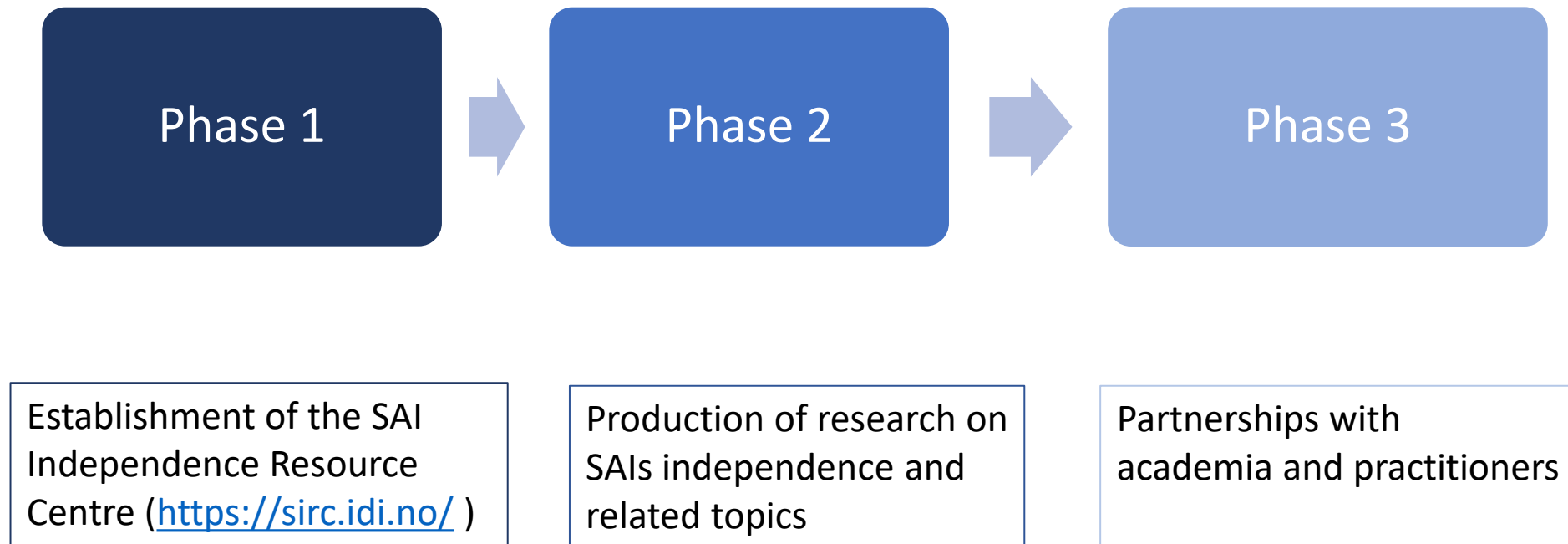


SAI Independence: SIRAM – points for consideration

- SIRAM as a tool is gaining popularity at the global level and in the SAI community
- INTOSAI is considered as a credible voice on SAI Independence both at the global and country level (No distinction between IDI and INTOSAI and its bodies at the Country level)
- Effective advocacy is highly dependent on greater coordination and follow-up at the country level
- Effective advocacy could be enhanced by the establishment of a continuous monitoring function to identify windows of opportunity

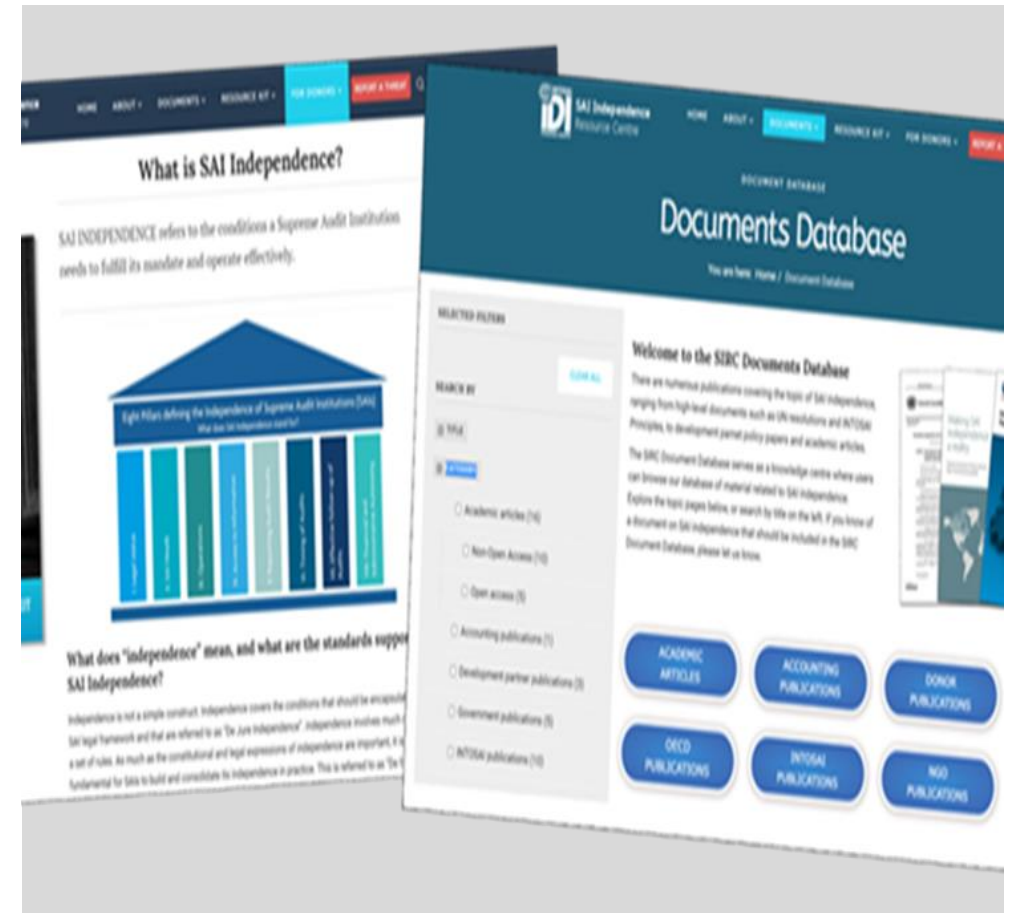
Establishment of a knowledge function

SAI Independence Literature Review

1. To synthesize conceptions of SAI independence from both academic and practitioner* literature
2. To illustrate the foundational role that INTOSAI guidance documents play in shaping the global conversation on SAI independence.
3. To identify the salience of SAI independence to achieve full implementation of the SDGs and build more inclusive societies



The SAI Independence Resource Kit is intended to serve as a quick reference guide for donor staff that will help them better understand the challenges SAIs face in obtaining and safeguarding independence and will assist them to effectively advocate for SAI independence at the global, regional and in-country levels.



SAI Independence: Research function – way forward

Expanding the research agenda will be critical to reach out to broader audiences and identify research gaps where our work could add value. In the upcoming months we will focus on the following:

- Adapt the resource kit to different target groups including parliamentarians and CSO's
- commission research on the impact of Covid-19 on SAI Independence
- Produce research on the SAIs following the board Model
